The Expert Committee interacted with the stakeholders such as Vice-Chancellors of the universities, Principals of the colleges and Academia through various electronic means such as email, phone, WhatsApp, online meetings, etc. and submitted its Report to the UGC.</p> <p>Based on the recommendations of the Expert Committee, the Commission has developed <i>Guidelines on Examinations and Academic Calendar for the Universities (Annexure-1)</i>.
